- LOUISIANA AND MARYLAND: Any person who knowingly and wilfully presents a false or fraudulent claim for payment of a loss or benefit or who knowingly and wilfully presents false information in an application for insurance is guilty of a crime and may be subject to fines and confinement in prison.
- MAINE, TENNESSEE, VIRGINIA AND WASHINGTON: It is a crime to knowingly provide false, incomplete or misleading information to an insurer to defraud the insurer. Penalties may include imprisonment, fines or denial of insurance benefits.
- MINNESOTA: A person who files a claim with intent to defraud or helps commit a fraud against an insurer is guilty of a crime.
- OKLAHOMA: Any person who knowingly, and with intent to injure, defraud or deceive any insurer, makes any claim for the proceeds of an insurance policy containing any false, incomplete or misleading information is guilty of a felony.
- PENNSYLVANIA: Any person who knowingly and with intent to defraud any insurance company or other person files an application for insurance or statement of claim containing any materially false information or conceals for the purpose of misleading, information concerning any fact material thereto commits a fraudulent insurance act, which is a crime and subjects such person to criminal and civil penalties.
